By this order we will dispose of two appeals bearing No. 128 of 2021 and 129 of 2021.

In both the appeals, an application has been moved that the issues have been resolved amicably between the parties and therefore a prayer has been made that the appeal be disposed of in terms of the settlement which is on record as Mark 'A'

It is prayed in the application that the amount be disbursed in the following manner.

(IN APPEAL NO.128 OF 2021)

- a. Rs.47,67,961/- be released in favour of the respondents (i.e. Rs.23,83,980.5/- in favour of Respondent No.1 and Respondent No.2 each);
- b. The remaining amount of Rs.37,86,864/- be released in favour of the appellant.
- c. The total interest accrued (till the date of release) on the total amount of Rs.85,54,825/- deposited by the appellant be released in favour of the appellant.



(IN APPEAL NO.129 OF 2021)

- a. Rs.70,11,910/- be released in favour of the respondents (i.e. Rs.35,05,955/- in favour of Respondent No.1 and Respondent No.2 each);
- b. The remaining amount of Rs.10,36,355/- be released in favour of the appellant.
- c. The total interest accrued (till the date of release) on the total amount of Rs.80,48,265/- deposited by the appellant be released in favour of the appellant.

Since the aforesaid is a part of the settlement itself, we deem it appropriate to pass orders that the amounts deposited by the appellant in <u>Appeal No.128 of 2021</u> and <u>Appeal No.129 of 2021</u> as a measure of compliance of Section 43(5) of the Act be disbursed in the manner prayed for and as noticed above, forthwith.

The appeals stand disposed of in terms of the settlement.
